In this issue, we have two articles on microRNA profiling in placenta pathology, namely on molar pregnancy and placenta of mother with antiphospholipid syndrome.^{1,2} Interestingly, these studies identified specific microRNAs that were differentially expressed. MiR-518a-5p was found to be consistently down-regulated in complete hydatidiform mole compared to partial hydatidiform mole. While, miR-525-5p was found to be down-regulated in placenta of mother with antiphospholipid syndrome.

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
